Chun Castle is situated in a dramatic location in the Parish of Morvah in the far West of Penwith. Its location provides amazing views of the rugged North Cornish Coast and its Mining Heritage. It is also possible while visiting the site, to see some of the other historical sites within its vicinity such as Chun Quoit and the Men-an-Tol Stone. The castle itself is the remains of a Bronze Age settlement. PAROW has done significant work in manging the bracken that had previously overrun the site..

It can be reached from a small parking area next to Trehyllys Farm (SW 408 336).

It can also be reached from a car park at Woon Gumpus (SW 393 333). From the car park head across the moor first to Chun Quoit and then on to reach Chun Castle.
